NAVAJYOTHY BETHANY VIDYAPEETH

A Missionary Educational Apostolate of Bethany

On 22nd July 2016, Bethany Navajyothy Vidyapeeth, a primary school, was established by a Provincial Decree and blessed by Fr. William Nedumpurathu OIC the then Provincial of the Navajyothy Province. The foundation stone was laid on 25th May 2016 and blessed by Fr. Benedict OIC, the founder and first principal of the school. Initially, classes were conducted in a small building.

The foundation stone for the new building was blessed by His Excellency Bishop Thomas Mar Anthonios OIC. Due to architectural modifications, a revised foundation was later laid and blessed by Fr. Jose Kuruvila OIC, then Superior General, on 15th January 2020. The new school building was blessed on 7th March 2024 by His Excellency Mathews Mar Pachomios OIC, Bishop of the Pune-Khadki Exarchate.

The school's recognition process was a long and dedicated effort by the Fathers of the Titwala Ashram. Their relentless work in securing the necessary documentation led to the school's official recognition in 2024. This year, the first batch of Class 10 students appeared for the State Board exams. Special gratitude to all the Fathers who contributed: Fr. Joseph Menakaleeckal OIC, Fr. Benedict Kaniyantayyathu OIC, Fr. Thomas Bijili OIC, Fr. Varghese Manoj OIC, Fr. Job Daniel OIC, Fr. Geevarghese Panicker OIC, Fr. Mathew Praful OIC, Fr. Cyril Michael OIC, Fr. Justin Thomas OIC, and Fr. Renju Francis OIC.

In light of the current political climate, our apostolic mission continues to grow indirectly. The school offers quality education to financially underprivileged children. During vacations, English coaching and tuition classes are provided for local students. As of the 2024-25 academic year, three Fathers reside in the Ashram and serve as Vicars of the Thane, Ulhasnagar, and Dombivli parishes in the Pune-Khadki Diocese.

OBJECTIVES & IDEALS

We help an individual to help himself to become what he should be. A child is a bundle of possibilities and we help to unveil them. Initiated to the ocean of knowledge, we help him to go to the depth and width of it. We act as a catalytic agent in his imbibing knowledge, developing mental, physical and intellectual faculties.

Lack of self - discipline and willingness to face hardships seem to be the two serious defects in the growing generation of the present society. Selfishness and individualism are at its zenith. Children should be given proper values along with knowledge. Being aware of this, the Management and the staff help the students to imbibe great values of life. Navajyothy Bethany Vidyapeeth makes a student wise rather than a knowledge able individual.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

DIRECTIVES TO STUDENTS

Read the directives carefully and sign the declaration given on the first page of the handbook

1. Navajyothy Bethany Vidyapeeth students are expected to behave in a respectful manner on and outside the school campus
2. Students should be neat and clean in person and dress.
3. Class rooms and school premises should be kept neat and clean.
4. They should reach the school before second bell and be prompt in taking part in the assembly before the class.
5. They have to come well prepared with all the lessons previously done and after doing the day's home work properly. Regular tests will be conducted, based on which, an evaluation report will be prepared and parents will be informed about the same on a scheduled date.
6. Examinations and other activities of evaluation are compulsory to all. Any malpractice during these evaluations will be strictly punished.
7. Politeness and courtesy of speech and conduct will be inculcated by insistence and training.
8. Quarrelsome nature, habitual idleness, dishonesty and disobedience or disrespect to teachers and elders will be very seriously viewed and dealt with accordingly.
9. Running, playing or shouting inside the school building is not allowed. No student will enter any class other than his or her own without permission.
10. When students move along the corridors they must walk in silence and in a single file. They should always keep left.
11. The school shall not be held responsible in any way for any illness, injury, accident or mishap to any student, but first aid and medical assistance will be given if found necessary.
12. Students must be disciplined in common places like cafeteria, auditorium, bus, toilet, library, laboratory, play grounds etc.
13. Students should greet in respect all teachers, staff and elders in the campus.
14. Students are expected to be out of the school building within 15 minutes following the school dispersal. Only students involved in staff-supervised activities are permitted to remain in the campus.

15. If at the start of the class the teacher has not arrived, the class leader will see that order and silence is maintained. If after three minutes, the teacher has not yet arrived, the leader should send the assistant leader to inform the Principal/Vice Principal. 16. Students may not be summoned to answer telephone calls during class time.
16. Navajyothy Bethany Vidyapeeth is an English medium school and its medium of instruction is English. Staff and students are expected to speak only English in the school campus.
17. No student should absent himself/herself without prior sanction.
18. Leave of absence must be obtained from the Principal by written application from the parent/guardian.
19. Repeated or extended absence of fifteen days or more without leave renders the student liable to have his name struck off the rolls. Re-admission, if granted, will only be after payment of fresh admission fee.
20. Students who absent themselves from Examinations for any reason other than sickness justified by a Doctor's Certificate, will be considered as having failed for that particular examination.
21. Any damage or loss of the school properties caused by the students, will be notified to their parents or guardians in time and it shall be their obligation to make good the damage.
22. Each student is given an identity card; and a copy of this card should be carried by the guardian or the parent for all matters with regard to the student and should be produced on demand.
23. Every student is responsible for the safe keeping of his or her own belongings. The school will not take up any responsibility for their loss.
24. Any student who is persistently insubordinate or repeatedly or willfully mischievous or guilty of malpractices in connection with exams or has committed an act of serious indiscipline or who is in the opinion of the head of the school has an unwholesome influence on the fellow mates, may be expelled prematurely or debarred from the school for a specific period of time.
25. In case of child suffering from a transmittable illness, it is recommended that you don't send the child to school. A medical certificate stating complete recovery from infection should be produced on child's resumption to the school.
26. Students should drain the excess water into the plant's pot instead of wasting water.

27. Only those students who have paid the fees are eligible to participate in extracurricular activities.
28. Please note that there will be an additional charge for AI and Robotics Activity.
29. Students should come in complete school uniform prescribed uniform, I-Card, shoes and socks.

LIBRARY RULES

- Maintain silence in the library.
- Books must be returned on time.
- Do not damage or write on books.
- A student can issue only limited books at a time.

COMPUTER LAB RULES

- Handle computers carefully.
- Do not install or download anything without permission.
- Maintain silence in the lab.
- Follow the teacher's instructions.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Respect teachers and school staff.
- Help classmates and juniors.
- Protect school property.
- Represent the school with good behavior everywhere.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

The school solicits your cooperation to help bring out the best in the child fulfilling the goals of education. Parents are exhorted to pay due attention to these aspects of a child's growth and work hand in hand with the school.

1. Parents are requested to go through the student handbook and be fully aware of the rules and regulations of the school.
2. The school insists on punctuality, regular school attendance, regulation regarding school uniform, cleanliness in dress, good grooming and fidelity to study and work assignments.
3. Parents should take interest in the child's academic and non-academic areas of growth.
4. Parents may visit the official website of the school for necessary information on working of the school.
5. Parents may meet the teachers on OPEN HOUSE days to discuss matters relating to your wards.
6. Parents may meet the Principal on weekdays between 10 am and 1 pm only
7. Parents are requested not to enter the classroom to see their children or teachers during school hours.
8. Parents or visitors are not allowed to move around through the corridors during class hours.
9. Parents should ensure that their children do not bring any valuables or electronic gadget / mobile phone to school. They should also discourage buying and bringing of expensive items, including stationery and other items.
10. The school discourages absenteeism and parents should not allow the students to skip classes.
11. Parents should make sure that for any absence from the school, a written intimation is sent to the class teacher.
12. Absence from school for merely social functions is discouraged.
13. Only parents are authorized to collect their child from the school.
14. "If a parent has an objection to rule 13, he/she may inform the Principal accordingly.
15. Parents must affix their photographs in the space given in the student handbook. A guardian's name and photo may be given on the profile page of the student handbook so that in case of an emergency where

the parent is unavailable, the student can be allowed to leave with the guardian.

16. A parent/ authorized guardian requiring to collect his/her ward must first report at the school office.
17. Special permission for a student to leave the campus must be sanctioned only by the Principal/Vice Principal.
18. Parents are advised to attend all scheduled PTMs (Parent Teacher Meetings). Parents and guardians are expected to respond seriously to any call from the school to discuss matters concerning their wards. This is essential for the welfare and progress of the students.
19. Parents are to notify the school regarding any changes in their address or contact numbers
20. Parents are to provide ample opportunities to their children to converse in English at home.
21. Parents must refrain from criticism of any teacher or authority of the school in front of their children.
22. Parents are requested to go through the fee structure and ensure that all instalments are paid on time.
23. Please note that the CBSE curriculum (based on NCERT textbooks) is followed for Classes 1 to 8. For Classes 9 and 10, we adhere to the Maharashtra State Board curriculum.
24. All the policies mentioned above are applicable for the current academic year. The management reserves the right to amend or update these policies as and when required.
25. Kindly note that photos and videos of activities and programmes will be shared on social media. If you have any concerns, please inform the school office in advance.

OUT PASS POLICY

- i If any parent wants to take their ward from school due to any emergency situation at home or due to any illness, the parent must approach the school office and notify your intention to the school clerk and wait in the waiting area.
- ii An outpass slip will be issued from the school office which will be signed by the Principal and teacher in the classroom.
- iii This same pass has to be signed by the parent or guardian while the child is handed over to the parent/guardian.
- iv The parent should produce/handover this outpass at gate when inquired by the security guard.

EXAMINATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Exams are conducted according to the directions of the education department. Absence from exams is considered only on medical grounds. The same should be substantiated with a medical certificate.
- The results will be given on a stipulated day and time at the end of the scholastic year only to those who have cleared their fees.
- However answer sheets will not be shown and no request for the same will be entertained.
- Any malpractice by the students during the examination will be subjected to appropriate action by the management.
- If any student found cheating during the examination, the student will not be allowed to sit for that paper and his/her parents will be called to school. Student will get a first warning letter from the school Principal.
- Fine of Rs. 1000/- will be issued against the student who shall be found cheating in examination
- If the same student repeats the mistakes in other exams then the school is authorized to take strict actions against him/her.
- A team will visit each examination hall to check students and environment of examination hall.
- There should not be anything written on your examination pad, on your hands as well as on your respective desk.
- If in any case a student found anything written on his/her bench they has to escalate the issue to the Teacher present in the classroom.
- Promotions will depend not only on final exams but also the exams held during the entire academic year. Promotions once denied will under no circumstances be revoked
- Students failed to appear for exams shall only be considered to reappear the exam on medical grounds.
- Green card is compulsory for the exams

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

- Uniform is compulsory on all working days.
- School should be used compulsorily.
- Uniforms must be washed and iron after each use
- Students may come dressed up (modestly) in civil dress on their birthdays.
- Shoes must be clean and well-polished before coming to school.
- Girls having long hair must tie them in two plaits with black ribbons.
- Boys should have short haircut. Fancy haircuts are not permitted.
- Hair coloring / hair streaking is strictly not allowed.
- School belt is compulsory.
- Students should cut their nails properly.
- PT or other activities uniform should also be washed and kept clean after every use.
- Students shall not bring or wear costly ornaments, watches, mobile phones, camera or any other electronic items in school.
- These items will be confiscated. Only girls are allowed to wear small earrings or studs. No second studs or second rings are permitted.
- Boys and girls are not allowed to wear bracelets, bangles, chains, rings, friendship bands, tattoo or such decorations.
- While wearing color dress to school low waist/skin fit/ pencil fit pants, leggings etc are not permitted.
- Students are allowed to wear only black sandals with blackstraps for the first term during the rainy season.
- **On normal weather days students must wear black polished shoes. Fancy or designer shoes in black colour are strictly not permitted with school uniform.**
- Slipons/ Slippers/ Floaters are strictly prohibited.
- PT Uniform is compulsory for the activity.

POLICY REGARDING CHILD ABUSE AND SEXUAL HARASSMENT

- NAVAJYOTHY BETHANY VIDYAPEETH management will have NO LENIENCY towards any complaints which comes under the purview of POCSO.
- Any child having any complain with regard to abuse incident can directly approach their class teachers, or any other teachers or the Principal directly or post a note in the compliant box.
- This will be brought to the notice of the CHILD GRIEVANCES CELL of the school which will be comprised of the Principal, Staff Secretary, One Lady teacher representative, PT teacher, PTA President, Lady PTA Executive, qualified medical practitioner from nearby government Primary health centre and an advocate.
- This case will then be reported in the nearby POLICE STATION for the further legal proceeding.

School Fees can be paid quarterly or monthly (for 10 months - June to March)

If you wish to opt for monthly fee payments instead of quarterly option, an additional charge of Rs.200 per month will be applicable for 10 month. Please note, once you select a payment mode either monthly or quarterly – you cannot switch between the two during the academic year. The chosen payment mode must be followed for the entire year.

Fine Details:

Monthly fees must be paid on or before the 15th of each month or the next working day. A fine of Rs. 100/- will be charged for late payments.

Fines will accumulate.
